

REACH Compliance Statement

Background of REACH Compliance

In June 2007, the European Union Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) was first released. The regulation came into force on 1st June 2007 and established European Chemical Agency (ECHA) which manages the Technical & Scientific aspects of REACH. This Regulation establishes specific duties and obligations for companies in the European Union (EU) that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparations, or in articles.

Consideration of REACH

REACH adopted to addresses the production and use of chemical substances and their potential impacts on both Human Health and the Environment and to improve the same from the risks that can be posed by chemicals. REACH also promotes alternative methods for the assessment of hazardous substances in order to reduce the number of tests on animals.

Amendment

Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/830 dated 28 May 2015 amending Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council on REACH and released a list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), 181 substances as per latest SVHC Candidate list, updated on 16 Jan 2018. REACH SVHC list is not a static list and it is updated frequently. Upto 28 Jun 2018, there are 191 substances on the SVHC candidate list.

Declaration

Talema Group is constantly monitoring the substances of very high concern SVHC), in our products. Talema Group products (articles) do not contain Substances of Very High Concern above the threshold value declared by ECHA mentioned the candidate list (191 substances as per latest SVHC Candidate list, updated on 28 Jun 2018)

Statement It is our intention to

- Identify all substances within our products and ensure that our suppliers (Manufacturers or Distributors)
- · Work closely with our supply chain in order to minimize & manage any potential risks associated used materials
- Communicate sufficient information to relevant stakeholders in order to provide information on identified uses within the meaning of REACH
- Follow the instructions on Safety Data Sheets and providing information on exposure scenario
- Provide our customer with information regarding hazards, risks and safe conditions of use of our products through material Safety Data Sheets
- Continuously monitor the presence of substance having more than 0.1% against complete 191 items from SVHC List and inform the customer if required. (Last updated 28 Jun 2018)
